The anti-corrosion layer on cable trays typically ranges from 45µm to 55µm for hot-dip galvanizing, depending on the tray thickness and environmental conditions.

Hot-Dip Galvanizing

Hot-dip galvanizing (HDG) is the most common and durable anti-corrosion treatment for steel cable trays, especially in harsh outdoor or industrial environments. The process involves immersing steel components in molten zinc, forming a zinc-iron alloy layer and a pure zinc layer, which provides excellent adhesion and corrosion resistance .

- Local thickness: Minimum 45µm for tray sheets 1.5–3mm thick; heavier components (>3mm) require ≥55µm .
- Mean coating mass: Corresponds to at least 325g/m² for standard trays .
- Service life: Typically ≥40 years in outdoor corrosive environments . The thickness is measured at multiple points using a magnetic thickness gauge to ensure uniform protection . HDG is preferred for coastal, industrial, or outdoor applications due to its superior durability.
