The thickness standard for galvanized (steel) Cable Trays is based on GB/T 14540-2020 "Cable Trays" (the latest national standard) and JB/T 10216-2013 "Cable Trays for Electrical Control and Distribution" (industry standard). Wider trays are typically preferred over deeper ones for power and solar DC runs to reduce cable stacking and heat concentration.
