

Types of MPO optical modules



Article Overview

MPO optical modules are classified based on connector type, data rate, fiber type, and application, with male and female MPO interfaces being the most common.

Connector Type

MPO optical modules use MPO connectors, which can be male (with guide pins) or female (with pinholes). Typically, the module itself adopts a male connector, while the MPO fiber jumper has a female connector to ensure proper mating. This male-female combination is essential for maintaining alignment and low-loss optical transmission in high-density cabling systems .

Data Rate and Standards

MPO optical modules are designed for high-speed transmission standards, such as 40G and 100G, following IEEE 802.3bm and other parallel optics standards. They are widely used in data centers, LAN/WAN networks, optical link interconnections, and internal wiring of communication equipment . MPO modules support parallel optics configurations like SR4, SR8, and DR4, enabling multiple fibers to transmit data simultaneously, which increases throughput and reduces cabling complexity .

Fiber Type

MPO modules can be used with single-mode or multi-mode fibers. Multi-mode MPO modules typically operate at 850nm, suitable for short-distance, high-density applications, while single-mode MPO modules operate at 1310nm or 1550nm, supp...
