

Using a 10 Gigabit Switch for Aggregation



Article Overview

You can perform 10GbE aggregation by creating a Link Aggregation Group (LAG) using IEEE 802.3ad/LACP, combining multiple 10GbE ports into a single logical link for higher bandwidth and redundancy.

Key Concepts

Link Aggregation (LAG) allows multiple physical Ethernet ports to act as a single logical interface, increasing throughput and providing failover if one link fails . LACP (Link Aggregation Control Protocol) is commonly used to dynamically manage these aggregated links . All member ports must typically have the same speed (10GbE) and operate in full-duplex mode .

Steps to Configure 10GbE Aggregation

- Check Switch Support: Ensure your switch supports 10GbE aggregation and LACP. Some models, like certain Cisco 2960S ports, may not support aggregation for dual-purpose uplinks .
- Select Ports: Choose the 10GbE ports to include in the LAG. For UniFi switches, ports must be sequentially numbered to work correctly .
