Dimensions

- Height (H): Commonly available in 50mm, 70mm, 100mm, and 120mm .
- Width: Typically matches the width of the vertical riser or main cable tray section; standard widths range from 100mm to 600mm, depending on the system.
- Thickness: Material thickness varies by manufacturer, generally 1.2mm to 2.0mm for steel trays.
- Fitting Type: Plugs are designed to slide into or bolt onto the vertical riser, often with integral side lugs or adjustable features for secure installation .
