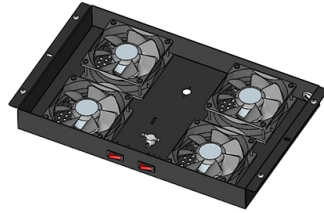


Vietnam Optical Line Terminal OSFP



Overview

The OSFP is a new pluggable form factor with eight high speed electrical lanes that will initially support 400 Gbps (8x50G). It is slightly wider and deeper than the QSFP but it still supports 32 OSFP ports per 1U front panel, enabling 12. This specification defines the electrical connectors, electrical signals and power supplies, mechanical and thermal requirements of the OSFP Module, connector and cage systems. The OSFP Management interface is described in a separate document, Common Management Interface Specification for 8/16X. Enter OSFP (Octal Small Form Factor Pluggable) — an open standard designed to deliver scalable, thermally optimized, and high-density optical connectivity for hyperscale, cloud, and AI-driven environments.
