

What are network optical modules made of



Article Overview

Network optical modules are essential devices that convert electrical signals into optical signals, enabling high-speed, long-distance data transmission across modern communication networks.

Core Function

Optical modules operate at the physical layer of the OSI model, performing optoelectronic conversion by transforming electrical signals into optical signals for transmission over fiber-optic cables, and vice versa for reception . They consist of a transmitter optical sub-assembly (TOSA), which emits light via a laser diode or LED, and a receiver optical sub-assembly (ROSA), which converts incoming optical signals back into electrical signals . These modules also include functional circuits, a main control board (PCBA), housing, and optical/electrical interfaces .

Types and Form Factors

Optical modules come in various form factors to meet different network requirements:

- SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable): Supports speeds up to 1 Gbps, suitable for enterprise networks .
- SFP+: Enhanced version supporting up to 10 Gbps, commonly used in data centers
