

What are the methods for cleaning fiber optic patch cords



Article Overview

Proper cleaning of fiber optic patch cords involves inspection, dry or wet cleaning, and re-inspection to ensure endfaces are free of dust, oils, and residues, maintaining signal integrity and preventing damage.

Inspection Before Cleaning

Always begin by turning off any laser sources and disconnecting the fiber from equipment. Remove protective endcaps and inspect the connector endface using a fiber microscope or fiberscope. Look for dust, oils, or residues, as even microscopic particles can block light, cause back reflections, or scratch the fiber surface, leading to signal degradation or equipment damage .

Dry Cleaning Techniques

Dry cleaning is the first step for routine maintenance and light dust removal:

- Cartridge or pocket cleaners: Press or peel to expose a clean surface, then lightly hold the fiber tip against the cleaning area. Rotate single-fiber connectors 90 degrees; for APC connectors, maintain the endface angle .
- Lint-free wipes: Use cleanroom-quality wipes to gently wipe the fiber endface without scrubbing or reusing the same surface .
- Compressed air: Can remove loose dust without direct contact, but avoid blowing moisture onto the fiber
