

# What are the methods of cable and fiber optic cable pulling



## Article Overview

Cable and fiber optic cables can be installed using pulling, pushing, blowing, or jetting methods, each suited to specific distances, cable types, and installation environments.

### Mechanical Pulling

Mechanical pulling is the most common method for both fiber optic and traditional cables. It involves threading a pull line (draw tape or fish tape) through the conduit, attaching the cable to the line using a pulling eye, and drawing the cable through the duct using manual or powered winches . Key considerations include:

- **Strength members:** Fiber optic cables contain aramid yarn or Kevlar to bear pulling tension. Always pull by the strength member, not the outer jacket, to prevent stretching or damage .
- **Bend radius:** Maintain the minimum bend radius specified by the manufacturer to avoid fiber breakage or signal loss .
- **Tension limits:** Exceeding the cable's maximum pulling tension can damage fibers or compromise long-term reliability .
- **Tools:** Pulling eyes, rollers, and swivel clips reduce twisting and friction during installation .
