Factors Affecting Cost

- Aisle Length and Height: Longer aisles and taller containment panels increase material and installation costs.
- Containment Type: Options include rigid panels, modular doors, or flexible curtains. Rigid systems are more expensive but offer better airflow control .
- Integration with Existing Cooling: Retrofitting into an existing raised-floor system is generally less costly than a full redesign but may require adjustments to CRAC units and airflow management .
- Density of Equipment: High-density racks generate more heat, requiring more robust containment and potentially higher costs.
- Energy Efficiency Incentives: Utility rebates or energy savings programs can offset initial investment, sometimes reducing payback periods to a few months
