Main Components and Circuit Types

A residential distribution box, also called a consumer unit or load center, receives incoming power from the utility and distributes it to multiple branch circuits throughout the home . The main components include:

- **Main Switch:** Controls the entire supply and allows isolation for maintenance or emergencies .
- **Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs):** Protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits. Each MCB typically serves a specific branch circuit such as lighting, general power outlets, or small appliances .
- **Residual Current Devices (RCDs) or RCBOs:** Provide earth fault protection to prevent electric shock. RCBOs combine overcurrent and residual current protection in a single device .
- **Busbars, Neutral, and Earth Bars:** Distribute power to the outgoing circuits and provide proper grounding .
- **Surge Protective Devices (SPD):** Protect sensitive electronics from voltage spikes .
