

What color is the fiber optic cable inside the optical fiber

Fiber optic cables use standardized colors for both the outer jacket and individual fibers, with yellow for single-mode, aqua for OM3/OM4 multimode, and a 12-color sequence for internal fibers.

Outer Jacket Colors

The outer jacket color of a fiber optic cable indicates the type of fiber inside:

- Yellow: Single-mode fiber (OS1 or OS2), designed for long-distance, high-speed transmission using laser light sources .
- Orange: OM1 or OM2 multimode fiber, typically used for LED light sources and shorter distances .
- Aqua: OM3 or OM4 laser-optimized multimode fiber, supporting high-speed networks (10G, 40G, 100G) over short distances .
- Erika Violet: Sometimes used for OM4 to differentiate it from OM3 in high-density data centers . These colors help technicians quickly identify the fiber type and ensure proper connectivity.

Internal Fiber Color Coding

Inside a multi-fiber cable, each individual fiber is color-coded according to the TIA-598-C standard. This standard defines a 12-color sequence for identification:
