

What does a 4-core optical cable look like



Article Overview

A 4-core optical cable is represented as a single cable containing four individual optical fibers, typically color-coded Blue, Orange, Green, and Brown, capable of supporting two duplex links or one duplex link with redundancy.

Structure of a 4-Core Optical Cable

A 4-core optical cable consists of four separate optical fibers enclosed within a protective outer jacket. Each fiber can transmit data independently using light signals. The cable also includes strength members (such as steel wire for outdoor or Kevlar for indoor use) to prevent stretching, buffer tubes (loose or tight) to protect the fibers, and an outer jacket made of PE for outdoor or LSZH for indoor safety .

Fiber Color Coding

According to the TIA-598-C standard, the first four fibers in a 4-core cable are color-coded as follows:

- Fiber 1: Blue
 - Fiber 2: Orange
 - Fiber 3: Green
 - Fiber 4: Brown
- This color sequence is critical for splicing, termination, and identifying fibers during installation . In loose tube constructions, the tube itself may be colored Blue or White, while the fibers inside follow the standard sequence.
