  - Removes the protective coating or buffer from the fiber without damaging the glass core. This includes manual or automatic fiber strippers .
- 4. Cleaning Supplies
  - Isopropyl alcohol, lint-free wipes, and fiber cleaning sticks are essential to remove dust and debris from fiber ends and connectors before splicing .
- 5. Protective Sleeves and Heat Shrink Tubes
  - Used to protect the spliced joint and provide mechanical strength after fusion or mechanical splicing .
- 6. Optical Power Meter and Light Source / Visual Fault Locator (VFL)
  - Tests the quality of the splice and ensures low insertion loss and proper signal transmission .
