

What is a CFP optical module

A CFP optical module is a high-speed pluggable transceiver that converts electrical signals into optical signals for 100G and higher data transmission over fiber networks.

Definition and Function

A CFP optical module (C Form-factor Pluggable) is a standardized, hot-swappable transceiver used in fiber optic communication systems to enable high-speed data transmission, typically starting at 100 Gigabit Ethernet (100G) and extending to 400G and beyond depending on the module type . It acts as a translator, converting electrical signals from networking equipment into optical signals that can travel through fiber cables, and then back into electrical signals at the receiving end . This ensures long-distance, high-bandwidth communication with low signal loss.

Form Factor and Variants

CFP modules are larger than SFP or QSFP modules, designed to support higher power and long-haul optics . The main variants include :

- CFP: Standard module for 100Gbps applications.
- CFP2: Smaller form factor supporting 100Gbps and 200Gbps.
- CFP4: Even smaller, supporting 100Gbps, 200Gbps, and 400Gbps.
- CFP8: Latest iteration, supporting 400Gbps and beyond. The progression from CFP to CFP8 reflects smaller size, lower power consumption, and higher bandwidth capabilities
