A card-type optical splitter is a modular, card-mounted passive device that divides or combines optical signals within a fiber network, designed for easy installation in patch panels or optical distribution frames.

A card-type optical splitter is a form of fiber optic splitter mounted on a card or module, allowing it to be inserted into a rack, patch panel, or optical distribution frame (ODF). Like other splitters, it is a passive device that splits a single input optical signal into multiple outputs (e.g., 1×4, 1×16, 1×32) or combines multiple inputs into one, without requiring electrical power. This makes it ideal for FTTH (Fiber-to-the-Home) and PON (Passive Optical Network) deployments, where multiple users share a single fiber infrastructure.

Structure and Types

Card-type splitters typically use Planar Lightwave Circuit (PLC) or Fused Biconical Taper (FBT) technology:

- **PLC Splitters:** Fabricated on a quartz substrate using lithography, providing uniform splitting, low insertion loss, and high reliability. They are suitable for larger split ratios (1×16, 1×32, 1×64) and dense network deployments.
- **FBT Splitters:** Made by fusing and tapering fibers together, often used for smaller split ratios (1×2, 1×4) and simpler network setups. The card format allows multiple splitters to be stacked or inserted into a single chassis, optimizing space and simplifying...
