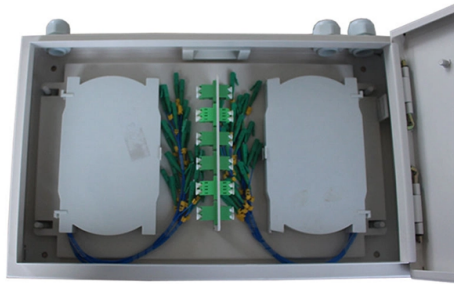

What is an Optocoupler?

An optocoupler (or opto-isolator) is a component that transfers electrical signals between two circuits using light, typically infrared. It contains an LED on the input side that emits light when current flows, and a photodetector (like a phototransistor) on the output side that detects this light and allows current to flow in the output circuit. This design ensures that the input and output circuits are electrically isolated, protecting sensitive components from voltage spikes, noise, or high voltages.

How It Works in a Module

In a module with an optocoupler, such as a relay module:

- The control circuit (e.g., an Arduino or microcontroller) sends a low-voltage signal to the LED inside the optocoupler.
- The LED emits light, which is detected by the phototransistor on the output side.
- The phototransistor then switches the connected load, such as a relay coil, without any direct electrical connection to the control circuit.
- This setup allows the module to safely control high-voltage or high-current device...
