Overview of FC Connectors

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Design: The FC connector features a threaded body, which allows for a secure connection by screwing the connector into the receptacle. This design is particularly beneficial in environments where vibrations may disrupt connections .

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Materials: The fiber end is typically embedded in a 2.5 mm ferrule made of zirconia ceramic or stainless steel, which is polished to ensure low insertion loss and high-quality signal transmission .

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Types: There are variations of the FC connector, including FC/PC (Physical Contact) and FC/APC (Angled Physical Contact), which are standardized under TIA and IEC specifications. The APC version is designed to minimize back reflection by using an angled polish .
