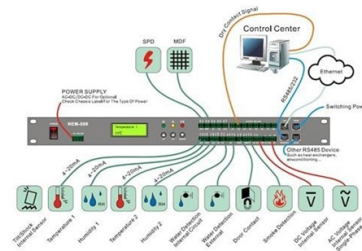


What is the SC pigtail used for

What is a Fiber Optic Pigtail?

A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber that has a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other end prepared for splicing. The connector end plugs directly into equipment, patch panels, or optical distribution frames (ODFs), while the bare fiber end is permanently spliced—either by fusion or mechanical splicing—into the main fiber cable. This design combines the precision of factory connectors with the flexibility to integrate into existing fiber infrastructure, ensuring low signal loss and reliable connections .

SC stands for Subscriber Connector or Square Connector. It is a widely used fiber optic connector characterized by its square shape and push-pull coupling mechanism, which allows for easy insertion and removal while maintaining precise alignment. SC connectors are known for low signal loss, high reliability, and are commonly used in cable television, internet networks, and data centers .
