

What is the appropriate thickness for fireproof cable trays

Fireproof cable trays typically require a steel plate thickness of 4 mm and a fireproof coating applied to meet national fire safety standards.

Steel Tray Thickness

For optimal fire resistance, metal plates used in cable trays should be at least 4 mm thick. These plates provide mechanical strength and act as a barrier against heat and flames. The width and height of the steel plates are often extended beyond the tray dimensions by approximately 200 mm to ensure complete coverage and effective fire protection. Before installation, these plates should be treated to remove rust, coated with anti-rust paint, and finished with a fireproof coating.

Fireproof Coating Thickness

The fireproof coating applied to cable trays must be uniform and meet the design specifications for fire resistance. The coating thickness is controlled to achieve the required fireproof grade, which is verified through inspection and testing, including combustion and endurance trials. A calibrated device is used to measure the coating thickness, ensuring compliance with national standards and project requirements. Proper application methods include spraying, rolling, or brushing to achieve a smooth, even finish without drips or bubbles.
