Core Function

The optical fiber terminal box (FTB), also known as an optical termination box or optical fiber distribution box, serves as the final access point in a fiber optic network, particularly in FTTH (Fiber to the Home) or FTTO (Fiber to the Office) deployments. It terminates incoming fiber drop cables and provides a secure space for fiber splicing, connector installation, and cable management. Optical signals from the central office travel through trunk fibers and distribution cabinets before reaching the FTB, which then routes the signals to optical network units (ONUs) or terminals in homes or offices .

Internal Components and Signal Flow

A typical FTB consists of:

- Outer shell: Provides dustproof, waterproof, and impact-resistant protection for indoor or outdoor deployment .
- Adapter tray: Houses SC/APC or LC adapters for low-loss fiber connections and cross-connections
