

What is the normal outdoor temperature for a distribution box



Article Overview

The normal outdoor ambient temperature for a distribution box is typically up to 40°C, with a 24-hour average not exceeding 35°C, and a lower limit around -5°C.

Standard Operating Temperature

For distribution boxes designed according to national standards, the maximum ambient temperature should not exceed 40°C, while the average temperature over 24 hours should remain below 35°C. The minimum ambient temperature is generally around -5°C to prevent freezing and condensation issues inside the box. Exceeding these limits can accelerate insulation aging, increase contact resistance, and reduce the reliability of electrical components.

Internal Temperature Considerations

Even under normal outdoor conditions, the internal temperature of a distribution box can rise above ambient due to:

- Heat generated by internal equipment such as transformers or circuit breakers
 - Direct sunlight exposure
 - Heat reflection from surrounding surfaces like concrete
- In extreme cases, internal temperatures can exceed 60°C, which may damage insulation and electrical coils. To mitigate this, proper ventilation, shading, and heat-reflective coatings are recommended....
