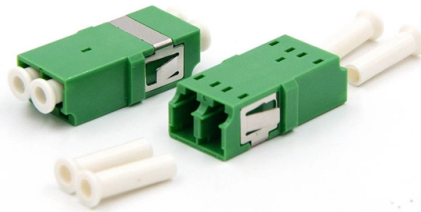


What material should be used for grounding the distribution box



Article Overview

Copper is the primary material used for grounding distribution boxes due to its excellent conductivity and corrosion resistance.

Grounding Conductors

For metallic distribution boxes, copper wires are typically used to connect the box to the grounding system. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) copper wire is standard, while in other markets, a 6 mm² copper wire is commonly used . For connections between mounting plates and equipment like spindles, larger copper wires such as 16 mm² (or 6 AWG in the US) are recommended to ensure low resistance and proper grounding . Flexible braided copper straps are often used for doors or parts that move frequently to prevent wire fatigue .

Grounding Electrodes

The distribution box is connected to ground rods or plates buried in the earth to provide a stable grounding point. Copper rods or tinned copper-bonded steel rods are commonly used, with sizes like 70 mm² bare copper conductors for bonding to neutral or equipment frames . The placement and depth of these electrodes are critical to achieve low ground resistance and uniform potential distribution .
