- **Stainless Steel:** Offers excellent strength and corrosion resistance, ideal for high-vibration or extreme temperature environments. It is heavier and more expensive than aluminum but provides superior mechanical durability .
- **Brass:** Provides good corrosion resistance and machinability. Often used in connectors where moderate strength and conductivity are required, but it is heavier than aluminum and less common in high-density applications
