

What optical module is used for gigabit optical ports

A standard 1G SFP (Small Form-factor Pluggable) optical module should be used in a gigabit optical port, matched to the fiber type and distance requirements.

Key Considerations

1. Data Rate Compatibility: The optical module must support 1 Gbps, which is the speed of a gigabit optical port. Standard 1G SFP modules are designed for this purpose and are hot-pluggable, allowing installation without powering down the device . 2. Fiber Type:

- Multimode Fiber (MMF): Typically uses 850nm lasers for short distances (up to ~550 meters). Modules are often labeled as 1000BASE-SX .

- Single-Mode Fiber (SMF): Uses 1310nm or 1550nm lasers for longer distances (10 km to 80 km). Modules are labeled as 1000BASE-LX, 1000BASE-ZX, or similar . It is crucial to match the SFP module to the fiber type; MMF modules cannot be used with SMF cables and vice versa. 3. Connector Type: Most SFP modules use LC duplex connectors, which must match the fiber cabling in your network . 4. Distance Requirements: Select the module based on the required link distance:

- Short Reach (SR): MMF, low cost, ideal for intra-rack or data center connections.
- Long Reach (LR/ER/ZX): SMF, for connections spanning several kilometers . 5.

Backward Compatibility: If the port is an SFP+ port, it can accept a 1G SFP module, but the link will operate at 1 Gbps. Conversely, a 10G SFP+ module cannot be used in a 1G SFP port . 6. Optional Features: Some SFP modules support Digital Optical Mon...
