

What size circuit breaker should the distribution box have



Article Overview

The correct circuit breaker size depends on the total load, conductor capacity, and safety margins, typically calculated as 125% of the continuous load or using NEC 80% rule.

Key Considerations

- **Determine Total Load** Calculate the total electrical load of all devices and circuits connected to the distribution box. For AC systems, use the formula:
 - Single-phase: $\text{Current (A)} = \text{Power (W)} / \text{Voltage (V)}$
 - Three-phase: $\text{Current (A)} = \text{Power (W)} / (\sqrt{3} \times \text{Voltage (V)} \times \text{Power Factor})$ Include all continuous and non-continuous loads .
- **Apply Safety Margins** For continuous loads (operating 3+ hours), the breaker should be rated at 125% of the load current or follow the NEC 80% rule: $\text{Breaker Size} = \text{Load Current} / 0.8$. This prevents nuisance trips and overheating.
- **Check Conductor Capacity** The breaker must not exceed the ampacity of the connected wires. For example, a 20A breaker typically pairs with #12 AWG copper wire or #10 AWG aluminum wire . Consider insulation temperature ratings and terminal limits.
- **Select Standard Breaker Rating** After calculating the required current, round up to the nearest standard breaker size (e.g., 15A, 20A, 30A, etc.), . This ensures compatibility with commercially available breakers.
- **Consider Breaker Type and Protection**
 - MCBs: Protect against overcurrent and short circuits, common in homes and office...
