

What to do if the power distribution box control cabinet trips



Article Overview

When a distribution box or control cabinet trips, first ensure safety, identify the cause, and then reset or repair the affected circuit.

Immediate Safety Steps

- Do not touch live components. Always assume the panel is energized until verified otherwise.
- Turn off connected appliances on the affected circuit to prevent immediate re-tripping ().
- Use personal protective equipment (PPE) if inspecting industrial control cabinets, including insulated gloves and safety glasses ().

Identifying the Cause

Tripping usually indicates an underlying electrical issue. Common causes include:

- Overload: Too many devices drawing power on a single circuit. Symptoms include tripping when multiple high-power devices operate simultaneously ().
- Short Circuit: Immediate trip upon energizing, often with sparks, burning smell, or hot wires ().
- Ground Fault: Electricity taking an unintended path, often through water or damaged insulation ().
- Faulty Breaker or Loose Connections: Aging or defective breakers can trip unnecessarily; loose connections can cause arcing and overheating (),....
