These provide organized access to fiber connections for maintenance and network expansion . **Horizontal or in-line closures** are particularly suitable for building-to-building connections or indoor distribution networks . **Specialized Applications:** For Fiber to the Home (FTTH) networks, closures may house preterminated drop cables with connector adapters, allowing plug-and-play connections without splicing . **Midspan access closures** allow selective splicing of certain fibers while keeping the rest coiled inside the closure .
