Installation Locations

Optical splitters can be installed indoors or outdoors depending on network design and environmental conditions:

- Indoor installation: Common in residential or commercial buildings. Suitable locations include the central computer room, building's weak current well, or floor wiring boxes. Indoor placement protects the splitter from weather and allows easier maintenance and cable management .
- Outdoor installation: Used in street cabinets or near the fiber distribution point for distributed splitting. Outdoor splitters are designed to withstand environmental factors like temperature fluctuations and moisture .
- Centralized vs. distributed splitting:
 - Centralized splitting: All splitters are located at the central office (CO) or nearby cabinet, using high split ratios (e.g., 1:32, 1:64) to serve many subscribers. This simplifies fiber management but increases optical loss .
 - Distributed splitting: Splitters are placed along the fiber route with lower split ratios (e.g., 1:2, 1:4), serving fewer subscribers per splitter. This reduces optical loss but requires more splitters and fiber runs
