

Where to connect the positive and negative terminals of the distribution box

The positive (live) terminal should be connected to the main incoming live wire, and the negative (neutral) terminal should be connected to the main incoming neutral wire, with all connections secured to the appropriate bus bars or breakers.

Step-by-Step Guidance

1. Safety First Before starting, ensure the main power supply is turned off to prevent electrical shock. Use insulated tools and wear protective equipment when handling wires (). 2. Identify Terminals

- Positive (Live) Terminal: Usually marked with brown or red insulation. This connects to the main incoming live wire.
 - Negative (Neutral) Terminal: Usually marked with blue or black insulation. This connects to the main incoming neutral wire.
 - Ground/Earth Terminal: Connect the green/yellow wire to the grounding bus bar for safety ().
3. Connect Incoming Wires
- Attach the live wire to the main terminal or main breaker input.
 - Attach the neutral wire to the neutral bus bar.
 - Ensure the ground wire is connected to the grounding bar.
4. Connect Circuit Breakers
- Insert the circuit breakers into their designated slots.
 - Connect each outgoing circuit wire to its corresponding breaker, ensuring correct polarity....
