

Where to plug the fiber optic cable into the router after it s broken

You cannot plug a fiber optic cable directly into a standard router; it must first connect to an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which then links to your router via Ethernet.

Step 1: Inspect and Replace the Fiber Cable

If your fiber optic cable is broken, it must be replaced with a new, ISP-approved fiber cable. Fiber cables are delicate and transmit data via light, so any damage can prevent connectivity. Handle the connectors carefully and avoid touching the glass tips to prevent contamination or signal loss .

Step 2: Connect the Fiber to the ONT

Locate the ONT provided by your ISP. This device converts the optical signal from the fiber into an electrical signal your router can use. Plug the new fiber optic cable into the ONT's designated optical port, usually labeled "Fiber" or "GPON." Ensure the connector clicks securely into place and remove any protective dust caps before connecting .

Step 3: Link the ONT to Your Router

Use a standard Ethernet cable (Cat5e or Cat6) to connect the ONT's Ethernet or LAN port to the WAN/Internet port on your router. The WAN port is often colored differen...
