Multimode Multimode fiber optic cable has a large-diameter core that is much larger than the wavelength of light transmitted, and therefore has multiple pathways of light-several wavelengths of light are used in the fiber core. Multimode fiber optic cable can be used for most general fiber. In practice, the choice is usually simple: use OS2 whenever you are crossing car parks or open ground, and use OM3/OM4 where both ends sit inside the same building or in adjacent buildings within a few hundred metres. Many SMBs standardise on OS2 for all new outside plant and on OM4 for new data.
