

Will splitting fiber optic cable between two routers cause lag



Overview

Using a splitter can potentially slow down your internet connection, but the extent of the slowdown largely depends on several factors. When you split a signal, the bandwidth available is shared among all connected devices. By dividing a single optical signal from a central Optical Line Terminal (OLT) into multiple outputs for Optical Network Terminals (ONTs) at users' homes, splitters eliminate the need for dedicated fibers to each residence—slashing infrastructure costs while scaling network reach.
