

Wiring of low-voltage distribution box switch box

Low-voltage switches should be wired carefully to ensure safe operation, proper LED feedback, and reliable connection to the distribution box, typically using structured wiring and correct terminal assignments.

Understanding Low-Voltage Switches

Low-voltage switches operate at 50 volts or less and are commonly used for lighting controls, building automation, security systems, and other low-power applications . They provide a momentary contact that closes a low-voltage circuit when pressed, often with optional LED indicators for feedback . Each switch may have terminals for the switch contact and an optional wire for a locator LED or common voltage (+24V) connection .

Wiring Steps

- Select the Correct Junction Box Use a 1-gang device back box with a minimum depth of 35mm, preferably 47mm, to accommodate wiring and prevent mechanical stress .
- Identify Terminals
- S1, L1 terminals: Correspond to the switch button number.
- Common or +V terminal: Connects to the low-voltage supply (e.g., 24V DC).
- LED terminals: Optional, for button or locator LEDs, drawing approximately 7.5 mA each at 24V DC
